John 2:13–25	Merchants in temple	Jerusalem at Passover	Upset tables; declarative statement
John 3:1–21	Nicodemus, a Jewish leader	Private location at night	Illustrated with birth; presented gospel
John 4:1–42	Woman at the well and Samaritan neighbors	A well in Samaria	Initiated conversation on topic of common interest; extended offer
John 4:43–54	Nobleman's family	Cana of Galilee, son sick in Capernaum	Long-distance mercy and miracle
John 5:1–47	Disabled man	At pool in Jerusalem and in temple	Miracle of healing and teaching
John 6:1–14	The five thousand	By the Sea of Galilee	Provided food to care for hunger
John 6:22–59	People who had been fed; Jews in synagogue	Other side of Sea of Gali- lee in Capernaum	Engaged the people with discussion and instruction
John 8:1–12	Woman taken in adultery; religious leaders	Temple	Turned the tables on the Pharisees; forgave the woman
