



Jesus Heals a Sick Lady

Mark 5:25–34

Bible story

One day Jesus was walking on the road with some friends. People were crowding around to see Him. They knew Jesus healed people who were sick. Jesus cares for people who are sick.

One lady in the crowd was very sick. She had been sick a long time. She had spent all her money on medicine and doctor visits, but she was still sick. “If only I could touch Jesus’ clothes,” she said, “then I would be healed.”

The lady got as close as she could to Jesus. She reached out and touched the bottom of Jesus’ robe. (Show picture 23-43.) The moment she touched His clothes, she was healed! She was all better!

Jesus turned around in the crowd. “Who touched Me?” He asked.

His friends said, “There are a lot of people around You, Jesus. How would we know who touched You?”

Then the lady told Jesus the truth. “It was me,” she said. “I touched You, and now I’m well.”

Jesus told the lady, “Because you believed I could heal you, you are healed.”

The lady was so happy. Jesus had healed her! Jesus cared for her, and He cares for you too.



Talk about the story

Have the children take turns pointing to the sick lady and Jesus in picture 23-43.

Ask: What was wrong with the lady? (She was sick.)

Ask: The lady went to someone special for help. What person did the sick lady go to for help? (Jesus.)

Ask: What happened when the lady touched Jesus’ clothes? (She was healed.)

Ask: Who healed the sick lady? (Jesus.)
